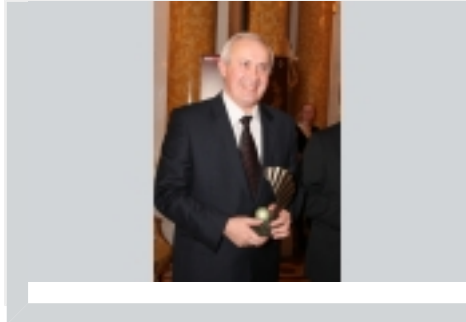


Professor Jan Lubiński, M.D.

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Professor Jan Lubiński, M.D. – a prominent oncologist, founder and director of the Genetics and Pathological Morphology Department at the Pomeranian Medical Academy in Szczecin. He opened Poland's first Genetic Oncology Consultancy Clinic in 1992 where he discovered that congenital genetic predispositions are crucial in cancer patients.

Professor Lubiński specializes in clinical and molecular genetics and pathomorphology of hereditary cancer diseases. He is an author and coordinator of numerous nationwide projects i.e. developing the network of oncology clinics and the European register of hereditary cancer diseases. He lectures in Poland and abroad. He acts as a state consultant on clinical genetics in Poland.
